The Grand Hampton Community Development District (the "District") currently owns and operates approximately 50 various wet detention stormwater management systems throughout the District which are located within Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, and 11, Township 27, Range 19, in northern Hillsborough County, Florida.

The current capacity of the District's facilities is not quantifiable, but the facilities have been constructed in conformance with the community's design and construction permits with all facilities currently considered to be operating at acceptable levels. The community is currently fully developed with no additional demands currently anticipated to utilize the District's facilities.

2. Provide a description of each public facility the District is building, improving or expanding, or is currently proposing to build, improve, or expand within seven years. For each public facility identified, describe how the District currently proposes to finance the facility.

No improvements and/or expansion are proposed, and the District is fully developed.
